REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
OCTOBER 3, 2011
6:00 PM

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Crout. The Invocation was given by Councilman Harvell. The Mayor led the Pledge of Allegiance. All councilmen were present.

Councilman Durham made a motion seconded by Councilman Harvell to accept the minutes from the September 12 meeting. A spelling correction was pointed out and all voted in favor of accepting the minutes with the spelling change.

Larry Finney from Greene, Finney, and Horton presented their audit findings for the 2010 – 2011 fiscal year. The firm gave the Town an unqualified opinion rating which is the best.

Public comments were given by Phillip Clardy, Ashley Creamer, Mike Creamer, Otis Scott, and Dave Awde.

BROOKDALE PARK RESTROOM BIDS Mike Allen, a representative from Goodwyn, Mills, & Cawood gave information concerning their task order and the things they would handle including the bid process. Councilman Looper argued that the cost of the plans was excessive compared to the size and cost of the building. Councilman Hagood made a motion seconded by Councilman Harvell to move forward with the project. The motion carried with Councilman Durham and Councilman Looper opposed.

FIRST READING OF AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE NEW CODE OF ORDINANCES Mayor Crout made a motion seconded by Councilman Hagood to adopt on first reading the new Code of Ordinances. The motion carried with Councilman Looper opposed.

COLE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION REQUEST Kay Rhodes, representing the Cole Community Foundation, asked the Town to place a concrete slab in the park near the playground to provide stability for a bench in honor of Doris Cole. Councilman Durham made a motion seconded by Councilman Hagood to approve putting the bench and pad in the park. All voted in favor.

Councilman Hagood made a motion seconded by Councilman Harvell to adjourn. The motion carried with Councilman Looper opposed. Adjournment was at 7:15 p.m.
