REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
DECEMBER 5, 2011

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Crout. The Invocation was given by Councilman Hagood. The Mayor led the Pledge of Allegiance. All councilmen were present.

Councilman Looper made a motion seconded by Councilman Hagood to accept the minutes from the November 7 meeting. All voted in favor.

Public comments were given by Willie Wright.

**PARK SECURITY
CAMERA
PRESENTATION** Mayor Crout introduced Billy Dunlap from Wildfire Connections. Mr. Dunlap presented information on how their wireless camera system would work, where equipment could be located, and the cost of a start up proposal. The network could also incorporate private business cameras as well. The installed price for 6 cameras and associated necessary equipment would be \$19,743. The Town would need to provide electricity, internet bandwidth, and access to tanks, towers, or poles. After the presentation, Mr. Dunlap fielded questions from Council. Mayor Crout made a motion to accept the presentation as information and requested Mr. Dunlap look at adding cameras to Brookdale Park and give us a list of other towns for references.

PUBLIC CONCERNS Mayor Crout announced that there were no bids received for the Brookdale restrooms project. Discussion about how to proceed followed. Councilman Hagood made a motion seconded by Councilman Durham to seek a Request for Proposal. Administrator Phyllis Lollis asked council for suggestions on finding contractors and a dateline to give the contractors. She further asked each councilman to give her their recommendation of contractors to contact. Councilman Durham said he would like to have the RFPs by the end of the month so they could be voted on at the next meeting. During discussion, it was decided that sealed bids were preferred but not mandatory. All voted in favor.

Mayor Crout announced that the next meeting would be on January 9, 2012.

Councilman Durham made a motion seconded by Councilman Looper to adjourn. All voted in favor. Adjournment was at 7:05 p.m.
