

TOWN OF WILLIAMSTON  
REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING

FEBRUARY 2, 2009

6:00 PM

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Crout. The Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance were given by Councilman Middleton. All presently serving council members were present.

A motion was made by Councilman Middleton to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. The motion was seconded by Councilman Harvell. The vote carried.

Public comments were heard from Pam Owens concerning use of the gym for the Williamston Historic Commission, and from Willie Wright concerning to get studies done on the intersections around the schools for traffic lights to be installed.

A motion was made by Councilman Looper to allow the Williamston Historic Commission use of the gym on June 13, 2009. The motion was seconded by Councilman Harvell. The vote carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Looper to have first reading on the two ordinances presented by the town attorney. They are ordinances to execute option to purchase real estate agreement for tract A-3, and tract B-1, both are in the Belton Township. These are for the upgrade to the wastewater treatment plant. The motion was seconded by Councilman Middleton. The vote carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Middleton to issue credit cards to Tim Gentry and the councilman for discussion. The motion was seconded by Councilman Harvell. Councilman Middleton amended his motion to issue a credit card to Tim Gentry only. The motion was seconded by Councilman Harvell. The vote carried.

David Meade asked the town council for \$9675, this is for the second phase of the Downtown Revitalization Project. Some of these costs would be reimbursable. The council decided to have a meeting with the committee on this before they would commit. This will be on the agenda for the next meeting.

David Meade spoke on behalf of the GWBA asking for one month's collection of the hospitality tax for entertainment at the Spring Water Festival. The council wanted more information from the administrator. Councilman Middleton made a motion to table this item until the March meeting. The motion was seconded by Councilman Harvell. The vote carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Middleton to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Councilman Looper. The vote carried. The adjourned at 7:00 pm.
