SPECIAL CALLED COUNCIL MEETING

JULY 20, 2009

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Crout. The Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance were given by the Councilman Cole. All members of council were present.

The previous council minutes were not voted on but will be at the next regular meeting in August.

There were no public comments.

Councilman Looper made a motion seconded by Councilman Harvell to approve on second and final reading the Floodplain ordinance addendum which incorporates Anderson County's ordinance and meets the requirements of FEMA. All voted in favor.

Councilman Middleton made a motion seconded by Councilman Looper to discuss purchase of a vehicle for the Police Department. Mayor Crout indicated that he had received a quote from Bobby Jones Ford in Augusta, Georgia for a price of \$26,400 for a 2010 Ford Explorer off the State Bid price. Councilman Middleton pointed out that obtaining 3 bids was not necessary because of purchasing from the State plan. After discussion, Mayor Crout called for a vote to purchase the vehicle. All voted in favor.

Councilman Middleton made a motion seconded by Councilman Harvell to adjourn. All voted in favor. Adjournment was at 6:09 pm.
